

Tips to Prepare For Your Photography Shoot

A clean and decluttered space will produce the best images for your listing. Follow this checklist to prepare for your shoot.

It is best to hide as many personal items as possible;

Potential buyers would rather imagine their own items on the shelves;

We normally photograph every room of the home, unless there is something you don't want photographed.

General Tips For Every Room	Bedrooms
□ Clean windows and all reflective or glass surfaces	☐ Make beds, be sure all loose sheets are tucked in
□ Replace all burned out light bulbs	☐ Make sure items under bed are hidden from view
□ Remove cobwebs from wall/ceiling corners	☐ Remove as much as possible from dresser
☐ Fix/straighten/open blinds and shutters	☐ Make sure artwork and frames are straightened
□ Make sure cabinet doors and dressers drawers close	☐ Remove excessive stuffed animals and toys
☐ Make sure framed artwork and mirrors are straight	☐ Move laundry basket out of view
	☐ Remove any temporary fans or space heaters
Kitchen and Dining Areas	
□ Remove magnets, artwork, photos from refrigerator	Bathrooms
□ Remove any items from the top of the refrigerator	☐ Make sure towels are clean and neatly folded
□ Put away all unnecessary appliances, dish racks, etc.	☐ Hide toothbrushes and other items from counter
☐ Make sure towels are clean and neatly folded	☐ Clean all spots and streaks from the mirror
☐ Clean stovetop and put away any pots and pans	☐ Put a small potted flower on the counter, if possible
□ Move or camouflage trash cans	☐ Move plunger, cleaning supplies, air freshener, etc.

Living and Family Rooms	
□ Move all toys, remotes and cables are out of view	Exterior
□ Straighten/organize books and DVDs	☐ Hide garbage cans out of view from street
□ Place fresh unburned logs in the fireplace	☐ Put colorful flowers near the front door, patios
□ Organize/remove pillows and blankets	☐ Move pet crates, beds, dishes etc. out of view
□ Remove any unnecessary furniture	☐ Move shoes, kids toys, sporting equipment out view
	□ Neatly coil or remove hoses
Office/Den	☐ Neatly arrange patio furniture and BBQ
□ Remove as much as possible from desktop areas	☐ Trim and remove dead or discolored branches
□ Organize or hide computer cables	☐ Remove leaves from pool, walkways and patio areas
☐ Straighten/organize items on bookshelves
